

Need Help Finding a Life Insurance Policy?



If you have a loved one that has died and believe he/she may have had a life insurance policy that you cannot find after doing a thorough search yourself, you can turn to the Ohio Department of Insurance for help. Their life insurance policy search service assists Ohio residents, and the families of deceased Ohio residents, in locating lost insurance policies or annuity contracts that were purchased in Ohio and issued on the life of, or owned by a deceased person. Executors, legal representatives, or members of the deceased person's immediate family may file a search request with the Department of Insurance.

To start the process, [click here](#) and scroll down to Missing Life Policy Search Service. Click here and you will find an instruction sheet and form to fill out. Once the form is complete, take it to a notary public for your signature and notarization and mail to Missing Life Insurance/Annuity Search Request, Ohio Department of Insurance, 50 West Town Street, Suite 300, Columbus, Ohio 43215, along with a certified copy of the death certificate.

The Department of Insurance then forwards the form, any attachments and the death certificate to all Ohio licensed life insurance companies so they can search their records for any policies or annuity contracts. If policies or annuity contracts in force are found and you are the authorized requestor, they will respond directly to you.
