The purpose of this program is to help disabled individuals quickly qualify for Social Security and Supplemental Security Income disability benefits. The administration lists various conditions that mainly include certain cancers and adult brain disorders, and a number of rare disorders that affect children. Early on-set Alzheimer's disease has also been added to the list.
